For dining, there's The Cliff House for evening cocktails and catch of the day; private dining in your own space with a meal prepared by a private catering chef; or Flippers Beach Bar, where breakfast, lunch and themed dinners are served in a casual bistro setting with Wednesday night barbecue and live music.

Enjoy golf on the top-rated Bahamian course or practice your serve on the club's courts. For water activities, choices include boating among the offshore barrier islands in the Sea of Abaco, where a 120-mile-long reef system provides shelter for a multitude of sea life. You can even plan your Sunday afternoon to include attendance at the popular pig roast at Nipper's Beach Bar & Grill on Great Guana Cay. Plans are underway to create dedicated boat slips in Little Harbour for Abaco Club residents. Sporty choices in the clear, quiet waters of Winding Bay range from snorkeling, kayaking and paddleboarding to Hobie Cat sailing and FunCat electric catamarans — or simply enjoying some downtime in a water hammock.
